

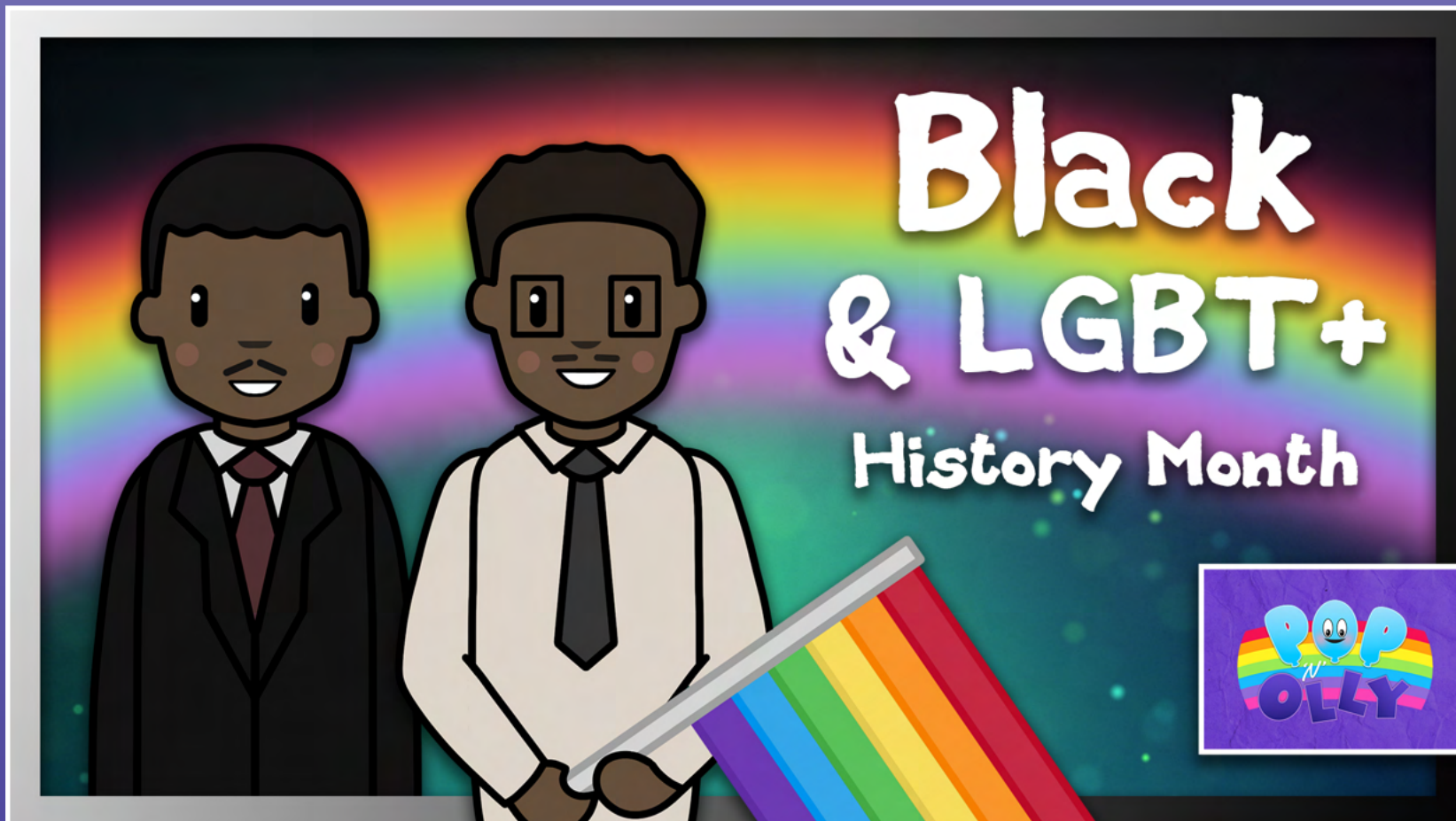
Bayard Rustin
